Before undergoing the examination it is necessary to remove anything that might degrade MRI images or will be pulled on by the strong magnetic field such as hairpins, jewelry, eyeglasses, hearing aids, removable dental work (when imaging the head or neck), key, coins and other metallic objects, watch and credit cards.

The examination will take around twenty to thirty minutes. Because of tapping noises you will receive a head-phone or ear-plugs and, for emergency, a small bell to hold in your hand.

It is important to avoid any motion during the examination.
